

CITY or HHCA RESPONSIBILITY?

Hidden Hills is governed by two separate agencies, the City of Hidden Hills and the Hidden Hills Community Association (HHCA). These two organizations have different managing boards, the City Council for the City and the Board of Directors for HHCA. Although the City and HHCA work closely on many projects, each has its own distinctive responsibilities.

The City's main area of concern deals concerns the health, safety, and welfare of Hidden Hills residents. These areas include Public Safety, Building & Safety, and Intergovernmental Relations.


HHCA oversees gate access, all infrastructure within the gates, and architectural standards. Recreation programs, with the exception of Fiesta, are run by HHCA.
